課程大綱： Outline of Lectures	本課程採用《當代中文課程》第二冊(2-2)內容，建立在《當代中文課程》第一冊基礎上為初級華語的進階歷程，此階段學習者將練習簡短言談的延伸，能開始使用已知訊息詞彙與句法創造自己的句子，更加具體描述事物與內容。 Based on "A Course in Contemporary Chinese" Volume 2 (2-2), this course is the next step for students who have completed Volume 1. In this elementary-plus stage, you will move beyond simple phrases to practice extended discourse. You'll learn to synthesize known vocabulary and grammar to build your own sentences, allowing you to describe things and express ideas with greater detail and precision.
