課程宗旨： Course Objectives	This course explores the dynamic relationship of gender, sexuality and culture from the perspective of language. It begins with the essential concepts of gender, sexuality and culture, particularly on the use of language in configuring identities, desires and attractions. It continues with the gender positioning concepts such as femininity, masculinity, bisexuality, and transgenderism, and the role language plays in the process. The course also covers the issues surrounding the discursive construction and re/production of gender and sexuality across cultures. This includes the access to public facility, in/equality in workplace, the representation in literature, the performance in drag/ballroom culture, and the microaggression in digital spaces. Although providing a practical knowledge on gender, sexuality and culture through language is the main goal, the course integrates some useful theoretical ideas, including feminism, intersectionality, queer theory and critical theory. This hopes to not only build students' base knowledge on gender, sexuality and culture but also sharpen their argumentation skills through salient tools of analysis.
