<p>課程宗旨： Course Objectives</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> —To work with topical content in the news as a way to provide comprehensive English-language training in reading, writing, listening and speaking —To help students develop an ability to use the Internet, and its many news sources, both efficiently and critically— —To develop in students a critical awareness of the events going on in their community and around the world while, at the same time, developing their ability to think analytically and productively in English— —To create a classroom environment in which students can develop a sense of relevance to the world in their study of English— 	
<p>課程大綱： Outline of Lectures</p> <p>In this course, students will find themselves fully engaged with topical content in the news—via the Internet as well as printed and broadcast sources—and will consciously and systematically use this engagement as a way to develop comprehensively their English-languages skills, in reading, writing, listening and speaking. By working in an interactive and communicative, computer-lab-based environment, students will work cooperatively toward developing their language skills via three main approaches: 1) Developing basic comprehension skills through step-by-step exercises as well as extensive skimming and reading/listening/viewing practice. The practice will be undertaken in a communicative, group-oriented classroom environment in which students will actively support each other in the learning process.</p> <p>2) Developing analytical/critical thinking skills through a) in-depth written analysis and commentary and b) oral presentation and discussion of selected news content.</p> <p>3) Developing an ability to think productively by actively participating in the process of gathering, processing and presenting news. This will be undertaken by guiding students in writing/developing their own original news reports, commentaries, letters to the editor, and/or news video content. If feasible, plans will also be made during the semester to take students on a field trip to an English-language newspaper, magazine, or broadcast station.</p>
