<p>課程宗旨： Course Objectives</p>	<p>In this course, students will practice speaking and listening in English, honing their ability to converse in English on a wide variety of topics. There will be a strong emphasis on student practice and every student must be prepared to speak in every class. Students will develop their interpersonal communication as well as public speaking skills. Specific attention will be paid to summary, narrative/descriptive/argumentative statements, and storytelling.</p>
<p>課程大綱： Outline of Lectures</p>	<p>In this course you will develop your listening and speaking skills, including pronunciation, intonation and conversational English. You will learn important grammar for daily conversations, and gain experience in discussing common and complex topics. Though there will be reading and writing, the strong emphasis of the course is on spoken English. Each class will involve a number of different kinds of tasks and activities, particularly speaking with your fellow students and working in groups. There will be some short lectures, but the course will stress student discussions and speaking. By the end of the course you should be a stronger speaker, familiar with argumentation, relaxed in public speech and more confident in your conversational English ability.</p>
