Students will learn the principles of quantitative research design and statistical data analysis in the fields of applied linguistics and language education. The course includes lectures, hands-on practice, and discussions of research papers and datasets.
課程大綱： Outline of Lectures	The course covers the following topics: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Overview of quantitative research methods; 2. Descriptive and inferential statistics for analyzing data gathered from quantitative research designs; 3. The fundamentals and application of inferential statistics, including sampling techniques, data collection, data analysis, as well as data interpretation and presentation; 4. Univariate and bivariate analysis (e.g., correlation, t-test, ANOVA, simple regression) using the SPSS statistical software; 5. Discussion and writing of quantitative research papers.
